CONSTITUTION OF THE UNIVERSITY OF CHICAGO

ARTICLE I. THE UNIVERSITY OF CHICAGO

SECTION 1. The University of Chicago shall be a body corporate with perpetual succession, organized under the laws of the State of Illinois, and shall have the right to acquire, hold, and dispose of real and personal property, to sue and be sued, to contract, and to do all such other things as may be necessary or proper to carry out its purposes.

ARTICLE II. THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES

SECTION 1. The Board of Trustees shall consist of not more than twenty-five members, to be chosen by the State of Illinois, and shall have the right to elect and remove its officers and to fill any vacancies that may occur.

SECTION 2. The Board of Trustees shall have the right to determine the general policy of the University and to exercise such powers and perform such duties as may be conferred upon it by the State of Illinois.

ARTICLE III. THE PRESIDENT

SECTION 1. The Board of Trustees shall elect a President of the University, who shall hold office for a term of not more than five years, and shall be eligible for re-election.

SECTION 2. The President shall be the chief executive officer of the University and shall have the right to appoint and remove all officers and employees of the University, subject to the approval of the Board of Trustees. He shall also have the right to appoint and remove all members of the faculty, subject to the approval of the Board of Trustees.

SECTION 3. The President shall have the right to call special meetings of the Board of Trustees and to preside at such meetings.

ARTICLE IV. THE FACULTY

SECTION 1. The Faculty of the University shall consist of all persons who are appointed to the rank of professor, and shall have the right to elect and remove its officers and to fill any vacancies that may occur.

SECTION 2. The Faculty shall have the right to determine the standards of admission to the University and to exercise such powers and perform such duties as may be conferred upon it by the Board of Trustees.
