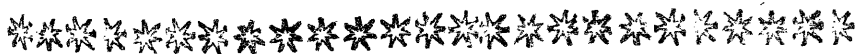

THE UNIVERSITY OF CHICAGO

CONSTITUTION OF THE UNIVERSITY OF CHICAGO

ARTICLE I. THE UNIVERSITY

Section 1. The University shall be a body corporate with perpetual succession and shall have the right to acquire, hold, and dispose of real and personal property, to sue and be sued, to contract, and to do all such things as may be necessary or proper for the purposes of the University.

ARTICLE II. THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES

Section 1. The Board of Trustees shall be the governing body of the University and shall have the honor and the custody of the seal of the University.

Section 2. The Board of Trustees shall consist of not more than twenty-five members, of whom not more than ten shall be ex-officio members.

ARTICLE III. THE PRESIDENT

Section 1. The President shall be the chief executive officer of the University and shall hold office for a term of five years.

Section 2. The President shall have the honor and the custody of the seal of the University and shall be the chief representative of the University in all its official relations.

Section 3. The President shall have the right to appoint and to remove all officers and employees of the University, subject to the approval of the Board of Trustees.

Section 4. The President shall have the right to confer degrees and to exercise all other powers and duties which may be conferred upon him by the Board of Trustees.

Section 5. The President shall have the right to call and to preside over the meetings of the Board of Trustees and to sign all resolutions and orders of the Board.

Section 6. The President shall have the right to exercise all powers and duties which may be conferred upon him by the Board of Trustees.
