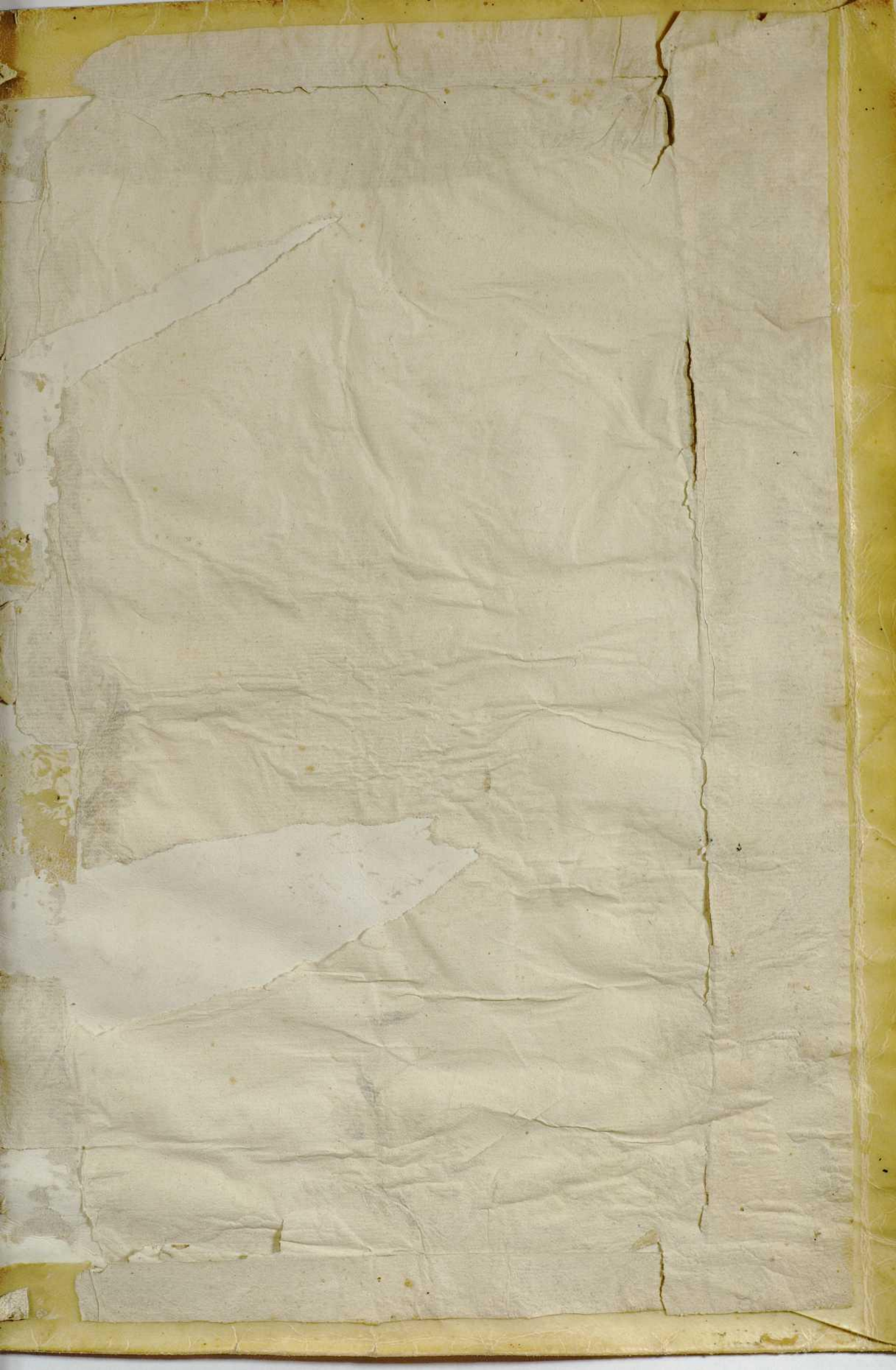

On this subject in the past we have seen  
 a great deal of interest on the part of the  
 Government in the matter of the  
 of which I have spoken in the past. It is  
 very important that we should have a  
 clear and definite understanding of the  
 nature of the problem which we are  
 facing. It is not enough to say that  
 we have a problem. We must know what  
 the problem is, and we must know why  
 it exists. Only then can we hope to  
 find a solution which will be both  
 effective and permanent. It is the  
 duty of the Government to see to it  
 that the interests of the people are  
 protected, and that the laws are  
 faithfully executed. It is also the  
 duty of the people to cooperate with  
 the Government in the discharge of  
 its duties. Only by the joint efforts  
 of both the Government and the people  
 can the problems of the nation be  
 solved.
